

Cash Flow: The Lifeblood of Your Business

Red flags:

- Profit on paper, but broke in real life
- Chasing late payments
- Dipping into savings



Quick Wins:

- Clear payment terms
- Use direct debit tools
- Keep a 3-month buffer



Tax: What You Need to Know



Let's break it down:

- Corporation Tax: 19-25%
- Self Assessment: For dividends/personal income
- VAT: If turnover > £90,000
- PAYE & NI: If you employ people



Tip: Save a % from each sale into a tax pot.

VAT: The Good, the Bad, and the Confusing

Once you hit the threshold, it's mandatory. But not all bad!



Pros:

- Reclaim VAT on expenses
- More credibility



Cons:

- More admin
- You're a tax collector for HMRC

Tip: Look into the Flat Rate Scheme or Cash Accounting.

Payroll: Getting It Right

Whether it's just you or a team, payroll is essential



To-do list:

- Register as an employer
- Run payroll monthly
- Report to HMRC
- Pay PAYE & NI






